Church Yearbook



LIFT sessions will be held at the Stone Ridge Yoga Studio twice a week for 1 hour over the course of 8 weeks and include an active warm-up, eight core strength-training exercises, and a cool-down. The program also includes basic nutrition information with an emphasis on increased fruit and vegetable intake.


