Isaiah 61:10-11

I will greatly rejoice in the Lord,
my whole being shall exult in my God;
for he has clothed me with the garments of salvation,
he has covered me with the robe of righteousness,
as a bridegroom decks himself with a garland,
and as a bride adorns herself with her jewels.
For as the earth brings forth its shoots,
and as a garden causes what is sown in it to spring up,
so the Lord God will cause righteousness and praise
to spring up before all the nations.

That unmistakable feeling of Christmas – the feeling of anticipation is in the air. In just a few weeks we will be celebrating! During the days leading up to Christmas, expectations run high. But will it be able to deliver on all the hype?

You know maybe all my life I've been expecting too much out of Christmas and not enough from Jesus Christ. Christmas itself cannot deliver all our heart's desires...but Jesus does.

What are your expectations of Christmas this year? What kind of feeling is in the air?

Would you like to have something to celebrate every day? Remember these words of good news from Isaiah, fulfilled in the presence of Christ Jesus, and you'll see what I mean.


