The word "**love**" appears 310 times in the King James Bible, 348 times in the New American Standard Bible, 551 times in the New International Version and 538 times in the New Revised Standard Version. The extremely varied numbers for the usage of the word "love" are due in part to translation. reference.com

It is interesting to note that the **first** time the word "**love**" is used in the **Bible** is in Genesis 22:2 – "Then He said, "Take now your son, your only son Isaac, whom you **love**, and go to the land of Moriah, and offer him there as a burnt offering on one of the mountains of which I shall tell you." napavalleyregister.com

**Four** unique forms of **love** are found in the **Bible**. They are communicated through **four** Greek words: Eros, Storge, Philia, and Agape. These different types of love are characterized by romantic **love**, family **love**, brotherly **love**, and God's divine **love**. learnreligions.com

The command "**love one another**" appears eleven times in the Bible, all in the New Testament. Jesus said it three times. Twice in John 13:34 and once in John 13:35. "Love each other" appears four times in the Bible, all in the New Testament. Jesus said it twice. Once in John 15:12 and once in John 15:17.

**“ Kiersten Swiegart is a beautiful, intelligent, sweet, 21 year old who is currently a Junior in Nursing School and is excited to become a Registered Nurse. Up until 7 years ago, Kiersten was a healthy young girl; however, in the summer of 2013 that all changed. Kiersten was having several bouts of severe abdominal pain, so was taken to her family doctor for evaluation. Tests would soon reveal that Kiersten had Crohn’s disease, but even worse, the auto-immune disease had attacked her liver leading to Primary Sclerosing Cholangitis (PSC). PSC is a progressive disease of the liver and gallbladder characterized by inflammation and scarring of the bile ducts. This can eventually lead to cirrhosis and liver failure. In time, medical treatment for PSC starts to fail and a liver transplant is needed. Kiersten is at that point and is in need of a liver transplant. Fortunately, Kiersten does not have to wait until she is gravely ill to have a liver transplant done, if someone is willing to donate part of their liver to her. Live donor transplant is a life-saving procedure where a donor gives a lobe of his/her liver to a recipient. The liver is the only organ that rejuvenates itself. If someone donates a portion of their liver, it will return back to full-size in 2 months. We are looking for healthy individuals that have O+ or O- blood to possibly be her life saving donor. Kiersten’s parents and sibling are not a match. Might you be the one? If you find it in your heart to be tested as a possible donor for this sweet girl PLEASE contact:**
